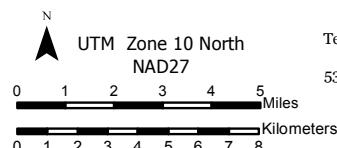


Glenn County Community Wildfire Protection Plan: Planning Units
